Linerless TC – LLP214

The Linerless TC – is in compliance with the rules of the Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come in contact with food and repealing Directive 80/590/EEC and 89/109/EEC, Official journal of the European union L 338/4 of 13.11.2004, modified by app. No. 5.17 of the regulation (EC) No 596/2009 of 18 June 2009, Official Journal of the European Union L 188 of 18 July 2009, article 3. As well as of the Foodstuffs, Consumer Goods and Animal Free Code (Foodstuffs and Animal Feed Code- LFGB) in version of notification of 3 June 2013 (BGBl. P. 1426), last amendment by article 1 of the Decree of 26 January 2016 (BGBl. Ip. 108), §§30and31), and are approved according to the (German Recommendation XXXVI for the health-related evaluation of materials and objects for the contact with foodstuff on the frame of the foodstuff and Animal Feed Code, 34th memorandum, Bundesgesundheitsblatt 10, 14 (1967), including the 219th memorandum, Bundesgesundheitsblatt 58, 1195-1197 (2014), state of 1 July 2015)

Thus the paper grade according to the sample material submitted may be used safely for food packaging. They may only stand in direct contact with such kind of foodstuff which are washed, shelled and/or peeled before consumption according to experience

LLP214 (Adhesive)

The LLP214 is examined according to the (Methods for testing plastic as far as they are used as customer goods as defined by the Foodstuff and Consumer Goods Act, including the 62th memorandum of the BfR on the examination of polymers, Bundesgesundheitsblatt 50,524 (2007), state of April 2007). For the composition of adhesive and the absence of substances which might endanger health and according to the Methods for examination of consumer goods, basic rules for the determination of the migration onto food simulants, according to the standard no. 80. 30, 1-3 (EC) within the Official Collection of Testing Methods according to §64 of the Foodstuff and Animal Feed Code – LFGB, state of April 2008, as well as to the Series of standards EN 1186, EN 13130 and CEN/TS 14234, Materials and Articles in Contact with Foodstuffs – Plastics current state, For the migration Behavior. According to the analyses performed, the labels coated with the adhesive grade can meet the demands of the Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and repealing Directives 80/590/EEC and 89/109/EEC, official Journal of the European Union L 338/4 of 13.11.2004, modified by app. No. 5.17 of the regulation (EC) No 596/2009 of 18 June 2009, Official Journal of the European Union L 188 of 18 July 2009, article 3. Confirmation of commitment

On the product Linerless TC – LLP214, we hereby confirm that no substances are used in the product, found on any list as suspected to be carcinogenic, mutagenic, reprotoxic or being endocrine disruptors.

REACH and its impact on Linerless AB.

REACH is the EU regulation for **R**egistration, **E**valuation, **A**uthorisation and **R**estriction of **C**hemicals. It entered into force on 1st June 2007 to streamline and improve the former legislative framework on chemicals of the European Union. REACH requires that chemical substances on their own, in preparations and those which are intentionally released from articles have to be registered to the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). The regulation applies to substances manufactured in, or imported to the EU in annual quantities of 1 tonne or more per company, unless the regulation indicates otherwise.

Linerless is 'downstream-user' of chemicals and we have taken the necessary steps to make sure that all our chemical suppliers are aware of the REACH requirements. All Linerless products are, on the basis of our current knowledge, not affected by the registration of REACH. We have continuous contact with our suppliers and we will inform our customers if there are new raw material restrictions.

Self adhesive Linerless laminates are not considered 'substances' under REACH, but are classed as articles*. None of our products contains substances from the ECHA Candidate List of Substances of Very High Concern for Authorisation of 12th of January 2017.
